Get perfect brows

We show how you can achieve that A-list look – at home

Angelina Jolie has perfect eyebrows, but you don't have to be a Hollywood star to have ones to envy.

Vanita Parti, founder of Blink brow bars, says you can get the look at home by following her simple advice.

"Grow them out before you shape them to get the best definition," she says. "When considering the shape, use a white eyebrow pencil to draw

a boundary around your brow. The eyebrow should begin no further than the bridge of your nose and the arch should begin two thirds along your brow.

"Depending on your brow shape, you may need to pluck below and above the arch, but don't make them too thin. Fill in any gaps with an eyebrow pencil and set with a clear gel."
